Our Patient Reference Group is very well represented by most groups although we currently do not have representation from the gay community. We are still actively recruiting patients for our PRG. Our web site is now live and patients can joint the group by completing and submitting a simple form. We are hoping that soon we might have a fully represented PRG.

Process used to recruit to the PRG group:

We included patients from our original Patient Participation Group

- 1. Put up posters in the surgery
- 2. Reception staff gave out leaflets to patients as they came in for appointments or repeat prescriptions.
- 3. Priorities were set by emailing newly recruited PRG members.

A simple survey of key areas we felt should be priority in the practice was devised. This was circulated by email to the PRG inviting views and comments. There was very little response from the group so we assumed they were in agreement.

The patient survey was conducted by paper forms given to the patients to complete when they attended surgery.

The results are published separately on our website.

An action plan was formulated from the results of the survey and agreed with the PRG by email communication. There were no areas of disagreement and no contractual considerations to the agreed actions.

The results of the survey were circulated to our PRG members and published on our website.
